## **Core papers 01 and 02:**

### **1. Theory (ANTACOR01T and ANTACORO2T):**

One Theory paper: 4 credit for total 50 marks

Internal assessment: 10 marks; End term examination 40 marks)

Internal assessment (10 marks): Attendance: 2; Class test / seminar: 8

(N.B. Marks for the class test / seminar to be credited by all departmental teachers together)

End term examination (40 marks):

2 essay type questions (800 – 1000 words answers) out of 4 options: 2x10 marks

2 short answer type questions (300-400 words answers) out of 4 options: 2x5 marks

5 definition type questions (25-30 words) out of 8 options: 5x1 marks

5 multiple choice type question: 5x1 marks

### **2. Practical (ANTACOR01P and ANTACORO2P):**

One practical paper: 2 credit for total 25 marks

Internal assessment: 15 marks;

Internal assessment (15 marks): Attendance 3 marks; continuous assessment: 12 (four assessments of 3 marks each to be assessed by all departmental teachers together)

End term practical examination (10 marks): Laboratory notebook: 5 marks; Practical skill and aptitude, viva-voce: 5 marks).

N.B. The practical End term examinations for ANTACOR01P and ANTACORO2P shall be conducted together centrally in the West Bengal State University.

## **Generic paper**

### **1. Theory (ANTG COR01T):**

One Theory paper: 4 credit for total 50 marks

Internal assessment: 10 marks; End term examination 40 marks)

Internal assessment (10 marks): Attendance: 2; Class test / seminar: 8

End term examination (40 marks):

2 essay type questions (800 – 1000 words answers) out of 4 options: 2x10 marks

2 short answer type questions (300-400 words answers) out of 4 options: 2x5 marks

5 definition type questions (25-30 words) out of 8 options: 5x1 marks

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## 2. Practical

**One practical paper: 2 credit for total 25 marks**

**Internal assessment: 15 marks;**

Internal assessment (15 marks): Attendance 3 marks; continuous assessment: 12 (four assessments of 3 marks each to be assessed by all departmental teachers together)

End term practical examination (10 marks): Laboratory notebook: 5 marks; Practical skill and aptitude, viva-voce: 5 marks).

**N.B. The practical End term examinations for ANTGCOR01P shall be conducted together centrally in the West Bengal State University.**

## 4. Miscellaneous:

i) A list of the Part-Time Teachers, Guest Teachers, and Contractual Guest Teachers may be asked from the affiliated colleges having anthropology departments. This data shall be used by the UGBoS for the purpose of confidential assignments in connection with university examinations.

ii) On the basis of report of the Chairman, UGBoS, the members unanimously took a strong exception to the fact that the recent appointments of CWTT / Guest Teachers in Anthropology in Gobardanga Hindu College, Gobardanga, North 24 Parganas had violated the extant UGC norms. Also, the view of the subject expert, nominated by the university, was also ignored. The BoS expresses its deep concern that such kind of appointments may in turn compromise the quality of teaching in anthropology and finally deteriorate the academic standard of the university in general. It was also mentioned in UGBoS meeting that such kind of gross irregularity in appointments also took place in the past, which were already reported to the university.

In view of the above, the UGBoS in Anthropology, WBSU, requests the university authority to immediately investigate the matter and take a strong action against such kind of illegal action in teacher appointment by affiliated colleges.
