
I am directed to say that, after careful consideration, the Governor has been pleased to accord approval to the proposal for creation of 42 (forty two) teaching posts for 21 teaching Departments of the West Bengal State University, Barasat as per the regulation of UGC for obtaining 12B certification as per the Annexure, subject to following terms and conditions:

- 1) Prior concurrence of Higher Education Department is to be taken before filling up of the posts.
- 2) The posts are to be filled up following extant rules & regulations of UGC and as per provisions of the Act & statutes of West Bengal State University, Barasat.
- 3) At the time of filling up the posts in future, the 11 (eleven) excess posts in 11 (eleven) teaching Departments namely Botany, Chemistry, Economics, English, History, Microbiology, Mathematics, Physics, Philosophy, Statistics & Zoology as brought out in the University's Annexure 1 of letter no. WBSU/VC/12B(UGC)/Tech.Post/87/12 would be abolished.
