CONCEPT NOTE

By integrating environmental stewardship, social equity and economic prosperity, our goal is to establish a knowledge base and generate ideas for robust rural communities that can withstand global challenges. The seminar seeks to address the pressing need for sustainable rural development, which has gained significant traction in recent years. The objective is to identify and examine the latest trends, best practices, and emerging issues in rural development and how these relate to sustainability.

The seminar will provide a platform for academicians, experts, practitioners and students to discuss and exchange ideas, experiences and lessons learnt. The seminar will focus on environmental stewardship, social equity and economic prosperity.

ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

West Bengal State University was established by the Government of West Bengal through an Act passed by the Legislative Assembly. The University started functioning from the academic session 2008-09 and was created due to a longstanding public demand for setting up of a university in the North 24 Parganas district. Additionally, the State Government transferred 57 colleges, formerly affiliated to the University of Calcutta, to the newly established University. The University is progressing rapidly and has implemented ICT-enabled classrooms, library and offices. The University's communication with students, affiliated colleges and the faculty is done through the extensive use of ICT infrastructure enabling instant communication and efficient governance. The Department of Rural Studies, previously known as the Department of Agriculture and Rural Development, was established in 2008 with the aim of providing a strong interdisciplinary education in Rural Studies. The Department offers a two-year Master's Degree programme with a curriculum that is both socially relevant and thematically updated to incorporate emerging innovations in the related fields. The Department welcomes students from both Social Science and Science Graduates (Honours) backgrounds to ensure an interdisciplinary approach to education. With three full-time faculty serving in a substantive post brisk Research is conducted by them individually as well as with the registered scholars to the PhD Programme under their Supervision. Different academic Departments of the University collaborate with this Department in terms of academic activities and the department has also taken up various extension activities such as preparing IEC materials and audio capsules on rural development perspectives.

SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS

Abstracts of research papers are welcome on the themes outlined for the seminar. Authors are requested to submit a 250-word abstract in English typed in New Times Roman 12 font size and 1.5 spaced. The abstract should clearly mention the following (1) sub-theme, (2) title of the paper, (3) name(s) of author(s), (4) presenting author, (5) affiliation (6) e-mail address and (7) 4-6 key words. The abstract must briefly indicate the problem/concept, methodology, and the major findings. Thematically relevant good-quality abstracts will be selected by a review committee. Abstracts should be submitted by 20th May 2024 via e-mail in Microsoft Word format to the following email ID: seminar.drs.wbsu@gmail.com. Acceptance of the abstract will be sent through email by 25th May 2024. The full paper is to be submitted by 10th June 2024.

SUBMISSION OF FULL PAPER

An edited volume will be published with a national/international publisher after the Seminar. Only selected papers will be considered for publication. The full paper should preferably be within 5000 words (including tables, figures, notes, references, and appendix) typed in Times New Roman 12 font size and 1.5 spacing in MS Word. The paper may be divided into the following sections: (1) Introduction, (2) Background of the study/ literature survey, (3) Materials and methods, (4) Results (5) Conclusion.
