NOTIFICATION FOR ADMISSION TO VACANT SEATS IN Bachelor in Library and Information Science (B.Lib.Sc.) Course. (Session 2024-25)

Postgraduate seats in Higher Educational Institutions are coveted. The West Bengal State University has followed all on-line procedures for B.Lib.Sc. admission. Opportunities have been given to all categories of students. All reservation norms and government orders have been followed. In view of the fact that some seats are vacant, the university is opening further the window of opportunity for admission to the students who had applied for online admission / not applied through online.

Applicants fulfilling the following criteria are requested to report to P.G. Section, WBSU as stated below.

i)Applicants should have to appear on the following date with an application / application form.

ii)Applicants who got chance but have not taken admission or did not get chance for admission or did not applied through online.

iii)Applicants belonging to both the Category A (Home University-80%) or Category B (Other University-20%) are eligible.

iv) The Vacant seats for Category A (Home University-80%) or Category B (Other University-20%) to be filled up as per merit score.

:: Important Instructions for the interested applicants ::

l) Eligibility criteria remain unchanged (as per PG Prospectus).

II)Selection will be purely based on merit and subject to availability of vacant seats only amongst the interested applicants who turn up for admission to the respective courses on the date and time detailed above. **No candidate will be entertained after the scheduled date as mentioned above**.

III)For Other University applicants having CBCS marksheets, "Honours marks shall be calculated on the basis of marks obtained by the applicant in Core Subject (CC) and DSE (Discipline Specific Elective) whereas General Marks shall be calculated on the basis of marks obtained only in GE (General Elective) courses. Such applicants are requested to submit the calculation clearly in the above pattern on the reporting date.

IV)All applicants are requested to bring all the original documents(MP Admit Card, Marksheets of MP, HS & UG, Caste Certificate, Income Certificate) and one set of photocopy of the said documents along with a printout of the Online Application form duly signed/handwritten application. If selected, the student will have to deposit the requisite admission fees as prescribed in PG Prospectus on the above scheduled date. If the student is unable to deposit the requisite fee on the schedule date, his / her application will be treated as cancelled.

V)During Physical Verification of all the original documents with the online data / application form submitted, if any discrepancy is found the selection will be treated as cancelled.

VI) Interested applicants should report to PG Section, WBSU as per the respective schedule mentioned at SI A within 12noon.

VII)However, University does not guarantee that the entire admission process of the students appearing on the scheduled date will be completed in a day. Hence, the students may have to appear on another day for completion of the same process.

vii)Admission against vacant seats for the above course amongst the applications received will be done as per merit score.
