- Abstract of around 500 words, Minimum of five keywords
- Introduction/ Background
- Literature Review and Research Gap
- Data & methodology
- Results
- Discussion
- Conclusions
- Policy prescriptions
- References
- All submissions should be in Times New Roman, 12-point size, single spacing, with a 1-inch margin on all sides, and references should follow APA style.
- Authors must submit their articles to <u>wbsuseminar@gmail.com</u>
- All submissions will be reviewed by a peer review committee.
- 25 Papers will be selected for the final presentation.
- The abstract will also be published as Conference Proceedings.
