Botany Semester-I, III & V Question paper format for online mode of examination 2021

In continuation of the pattern of question paper adopted (as per the earlier advisory received from the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor) during the pandemic for online mode of examination, the pattern will be as follows:

SEM-I- CC1 and CC2

Group A:

Q:1- 1x3=3 (compulsory)

Q:2- 3x4=12 (out of 6 questions)

Q:3- 5x1=5 (out of 2 questions)

Group B:

Q:1- 1x3=3 (compulsory)

Q:2- 3x4=12 (out of 6 questions)

Q:3- 5x1=5 (out of 2 questions)

SEM-III- CC5, CC6, CC7

Q:1-1x6=6 (compulsory)

Q:2- 3x8=24 (out of 12)

Q:3- 5x2=10 (out of 4)

CC5 Group-A Morphology (10 marks); Group-B Anatomy (30 marks)

Q1. All questions are Compulsory

Q2. Students must answer at least one question for each group

Q3. Students must answer at least one question from each group

SEM-V- CC11 and CC12

Q:1-1x6=6 (compulsory)

Q:2- 3x8=24 (out of 12)

Q:3- 5x2=10 (out of 4)

For **GE and DSE papers** same pattern will be followed as before


Q1. 16 X 1 = 16 [All questions Compulsory]

Q2. 8 X 3 = 24 [Out of 12 questions to be set]

For **Practical examinations**, internal assessment would be done based on the practical note book of the students which they have prepared based on the demonstration experiments shown online. The End semester exam for 10 marks would be conducted by practical based short analytical questions of 1/2 marks. All documents related to the examination process are to be preserved as they may be subject to post examination scrutiny.
